1. I have huge Safety concerns due to establishment of Village with known drug use amongst the inhabitants. I am opposed to inviting and housing Drug Users into a an existing neighborhood with families.

I do not support the project unless there is a guarantee of daily routine police patrols of the neighborhood.

2. Concern for Noise pollution from generators from 25 RVs
