INTRODUCTION:

This item is to request City Council Receive the Informational Presentation from Cynthia Stefenoni, Sebastopol Center for the Arts, on the upcoming event: SEBASTOPOL DOCUMENTARY FILM FESTIVAL, March 24-27, 2022

BACKGROUND:

The Sebastopol Center for the Arts is committed to cultivating creativity and inspiring appreciation for the transformative power of art. As part of their mission, the Center for the Arts produces the Sebastopol Documentary Film Festival.

In 2007, the Sebastopol Documentary Film Festival debuted, ultimately developing into a well-respected documentary film festival which attracts participants from the local, national and international filmmaking community. It has been named, "One of the 25 coolest film festivals by Movie Maker Magazine."

DISCUSSION:


