### INTRODUCTION/PURPOSE:

The item is to request Council Consider Receive the Presentation **from the** Marin Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The Marin/Sonoma Mosquito and Vector Control District, founded in 1915, protects the health and welfare of the communities it serves from mosquitoes and vector-borne diseases by utilizing cost-effective, environmentally responsible integrated vector management practices. The District is funded through a combination of property tax and benefit assessment revenues. A typical single family equivalent property owner pays \$12 via a benefit assessment and approximately the same amount through property taxes. The District is governed by a 24-member Board of Trustees. Each trustee represents his or her city of residence or a county at large. Trustees are appointed by their city council or county board of supervisors and serve a two or four year term. The City of Sebastopol's current representative is Vice Mayor Rich.
