## **INTRODUCTION/PURPOSE:**

This item is to request the Council approve the Sebastopol Solid Waste Collection Services Annual Rate Adjustment by the City's Franchise Solid Waste Collector/Hauler, Recology Sonoma Marin ("Recology") and the establishment of a subcommittee to negotiate a new franchise agreement. Annual rate adjustments are permitted upon City review and approval as per the provisions of the Franchise Agreement between the City and Recology.

A representative from Recology will be making a short presentation to Council regarding the proposed rates.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On December 16, 2008, Council adopted Resolution 5723 and entered into a Franchise Agreement (Agreement) with a local solid waste collection and hauling firm, Redwood Empire Disposal, also known as "The Ratto Group". The Agreement covered solid waste, recyclable and compostable materials collection and street sweeping services. Subsequently, on September 19, 2017, the Council approved the assignment of the Agreement from Redwood Empire Disposal to Recology. The original Franchise Agreement was effective January 1, 2009 and is set to end by December 31, 2023.

On June 21, 2022, Council approved an Annual Rate Adjustment schedule effective July 1, 2023 for services provided by Recology.

On April 18, 2023, Council directed staff to work with Recology on a new extension of the Franchise Agreement.

The City received a letter from Recology dated May 3, 2023 (Attachment 2) requesting an annual rate adjustment effective July 1, 2023.

## **DISCUSSION:**

Franchise Agreement Section 7.3 is titled "Adjustments to Maximum Collection Service Rates" which describes the fee elements and rate adjustment methodologies. In simple form, a "Refuse Rate Index", or RRI, is calculated and applied to several service components, such as Single-Family Dwelling, Multi Family Dwelling, or Commercial Collection service rates (typically per bin or level of service per month) based on several factors affecting costs such as fuel rates or landfill tip fees, for example.

The Franchise holder is required to apply to the City for potential rate adjustments based on complex formulas described in the Agreement, which must be timed to allow changes to be effective July 1 of a given year. Recology submitted their new proposed rate sheets and supporting calculations on their letter dated May 5, 2023 (proposed annual rate adjustments included in letter, attached).

Single family rate change for single cans weekly pick-up would range between 10.3-10.7% per month, with the actual monthly rate changes effectively in the range of \$1.57 cents per month to \$8.64 per month; the most commonly used 32 gallon size would rise \$2.78 cents per month. Commercial single can and bin weekly pick-up rates are requested to rise in the range of 8.2-11.1% per month. The actual monetary amount of the commercial single can and single bin increases between \$4.69 per month and \$61.23 per month; while the often used 4 cubic yard bin weekly pick-up would be increased by \$55.03 per month.

In addition to the proposed rate increases listed in the table above, the Franchise Agreement is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2023. Staff recommends that Council establish a subcommittee to begin negotiations for a new Franchise Agreement with Recology.

# GOALS:

This action supports the following City Council Goals and General Plan Actions:

- COS 9-13: Continue the citywide recycling program, actively encourage recycling citywide, including the recycling/composting of food waste, and advocate for a regional composting facility.
- COS 9-14: Continue efforts to reduce solid waste generation throughout the life of the General Plan.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

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The Recology Franchise Agreement is Categorically Exempt under CEQA, Section 15308. The City's action assures the protection of the environment since the Agreement contains several regulatory mandates for complying with state law for the disposal of multiple waste streams in a manner that ensures the protection of the environment.

## PUBLIC COMMENT:

As of the writing of this staff report, the City has not received any public comment. However, staff anticipates receiving public comment from interested parties following the publication and distribution of this staff report.

Such comments will be provided to the City Council as supplemental materials before or at the meeting. In addition, public comments may be offered during the public hearing.

## PUBLIC NOTICE:

This item was noticed in accordance with the Ralph M. Brown Act and was available for public viewing and review at least 72 hours prior to schedule meeting date. In addition, a Legal Notice was published on May 23, 2023 as required regarding the public hearing date, time and a brief description of the proposed rates.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

None to City finances. The rate adjustments apply to residential and commercial customers.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that Council adopt a Resolution to 1) approve the Sebastopol Solid Waste Collection Services Annual Rate Adjustments by the City's Franchise Solid Waste Collector/Hauler, Recology Sonoma Marin effective July 1, 2023; 2) establish a subcommittee and assign two Councilmembers to the subcommittee to begin negotiation with Recology for a new Franchise Agreement; and 3) negotiate a contract extension beyond December 31, 2023 if necessary.

## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEBASTOPOL APPROVING THE RECOLOGY SONOMA MARIN REFUSE RATE INDEX (RRI) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024 AND ESTABLISHING A SUBCOMMITTEE TO NEGOTIATE A NEW FRANCHISE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2008, City Council adopted Resolution 5723 and entered into a Franchise Agreement (Agreement), effective January 1, 2009, with a local solid waste collection and hauling firm, Redwood Empire Disposal, also known as "The Ratto Group; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement covered solid waste, recyclable and compostable materials collection and street sweeping services; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, on September 19, 2017, City Council approved the assignment of the Agreement from Redwood Empire Disposal to Recology Sonoma Marin (RSM); and

WHEREAS, the original Agreement is set to end by December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2023, Council directed staff direct to work with Recology on a new extension of the Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City received a letter from RSM dated May 3, 2023 (copy attached to this Resolution) requesting a contractual annual Refuse Rate Index (RRI) adjustment effective July 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing for said RRI adjustment was conducted on June 6, 2023 to receive public comments; and

WHEREAS, during said public hearing meeting on June 6, 2023, City Council discussed the establishment of a subcommittee to negotiate, in good faith, a new Franchise Agreement with RSM

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Sebastopol, as follows:

- 1. The contractual Refuse Rate Index (RRI) adjustments as stated in the May 5, 2023 letter from Recology Sonoma Marin, is hereby approved and effective July 1, 2023.
- 2. The subcommittee to negotiate, in good faith, a new Franchise Agreement with Recology Sonoma Marin (RSM) is hereby established.
- 3. The subcommittee members shall consist of the City Manager or his/her designee, and two Councilmembers, selected by the City Council.
- 4. The City Manager is directed to do all that is necessary to begin negotiation meetings as soon as possible, given the existing Franchise Agreement is set to expire on December 31, 2023.

The above and foregoing Resolution was duly passed, approved, and adopted at a meeting by the City Council on the 6th day of June 2023.

Dear Larry,

We are looking forward to meeting with you, Mary and Toni on May 10 to begin discussing extension of the Sebastopol Recology Franchise Ageement. Following this letter, please find the contractual refuse rate index (RRI) adjustment for rates effective July 1, 2023 per Section 7.3 of the current franchise agreement. This RRI adjustment will set rates for the final six month of the current franchise agreement, during which time Recology looks forward to reaching an agreement for extension of the contract to enable Recology to continue to provide collection services for the City of Sebastopol.

The RRI indicates an average increase of 9.9% for July 1, 2023. The 32G Residential cart rate in Sebastopol will increase by 10.4% or \$2.78, and the 4 Yard Commercial bin will increase by 9.1% or \$55.03. The rate changes are defined by changes in rate components as follows:

- 1. Disposal Component increases by 4.88% based on the increase in the MSW tip fee.
- 2. Organics Processing Component increases by 5.12% based in the change in organics processing fee.
- 3. RRI/Collection Component increases by 13.15% based on the weighted average change in publicly available Bureau of Labor Statistics indices for Labor, Fuel, Vehicle Replacement, Vehicle Maintenance and Consumer Price Index.

Following this letter is the rate application documentation including component increase calculations, a complete rate table, and a chart comparing the new Sebastopol rates with surrounding areas. Attached in a separate document are the Recology Sebastopol Audited Financial Statements for FY2022 and an excel version of the rate application to assist with review.
