

## LIEUTENANT RON NELSON TO BE NAMED SEBASTOPOL INTERIM CHIEF OF POLICE

### LIEUTENANT RON NELSON TO BE NAMED SEBASTOPOL INTERIM CHIEF OF POLICE FOLLOWING DEPARTURE OF CHIEF KEVIN KILGORE

Kilgore to join City of Rohnert Park Department of Public Safety

On Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Sebastopol Manager City McLaughlin announced that Lieutenant Ron Nelson will be appointed Interim Chief of Police upon the departure of Chief Kevin Kilgore, who will join Rohnert Park Department of Public Safety as Deputy Chief later this month. Lieutenant Nelson has almost thirty years of experience in law enforcement including twenty-two years with the Santa Rosa Police Department. Upon retirement from Santa Rosa, he was recruited and hired by the Sebastopol Police Department (SPD) as an Interim Lieutenant in September 2020. He has



overseen the SPD Operations Division since being hired and has worked in partnership with Chief Kilgore since February 2021 when Kilgore was brought on as Chief of Police. He has also served as the Acting Police Chief on several occasions when Chief Kilgore was absent.

City Manager Larry McLaughlin stated, "We have a great group of dedicated officers and staff at the Sebastopol Police Department, and I'm pleased that we can make a seamless transition as Chief Kilgore leaves us. Lieutenant Nelson has a wealth of experience both inside and outside of our department and is a well-respected leader in the community. We're grateful that he's stepping up as Interim Chief of Police. We thank Chief Kilgore for his service with us over the past year and a half. I know I speak for our staff and City Council when I say that we wish Kevin the best in his new endeavor."

In his resignation letter, Kilgore stated that the decision to leave the Sebastopol Police Department [was] not easy and continued, "I am proud to say that I was your Chief of Police, and I am proud to have been a part of the Sebastopol Police Department and the City of Sebastopol."

This is to inform you that the City of Sebastopol will be extending the Nomination Period to Wednesday August 17, 2022; 5:30 pm.

Incumbents (Glass, Gurney and Slayter) have not filed to re-run for City Council. Per Elections Code, if an incumbent fails to return Candidate nomination papers by the deadline (August 12th 2022 at 5:30 pm), the nomination period will be extended. Therefore, the City of Sebastopol is extending the nomination deadline to Wednesday, August 17, 2022; 5:30 pm.



## POLYSTYRENE FOAM BAN AND DISPOSABLE FOOD SERVICE WARE ORDINANCE UPDATED



The Sebastopol City Council recently updated its existing Polystyrene Foam Ban and Disposable Food Service Ware ordinance.

The <u>original ordinance</u>, which went into effect in November of 2019, banned polystyrene foam takeout food ware and retail sales (packing peanuts, coolers, etc.), and required that all take out food ware be either compostable or recyclable, with the exception of coffee cups and soup/hot liquid containers (for which there is currently no commercially available compostable or recyclable products). "Compostable" plastic

items (cups, utensils, straws, etc.) are banned, as they are not accepted by commercial compost facilities and are also not accepted in recycling. The original ordinance also required that food vendors only give condiment packets, straws, lids, napkins, and single use utensils upon customer request.

Effective August 1st, 2022, the updated ordinance, now named the Zero Waste Food Ware Ordinance, now matches the Zero Waste Food Ware Ordinance passed by the Santa Rosa City Council. In addition to the requirements in the original ordinance (above), the Sebastopol City Council added the following provisions:

- Foodware containing Per and Polyfluoroalkyl (PFAS) is prohibited
- Dine-In Food Facilities within in the City shall:
  - Only use Reusable Food Ware and Reusable Food Ware Accessories;
  - Offer Condiments in a Reusable dispenser or format rather than prepackaged single-use packets.
- Food facilities which provide customer-facing waste containers shall provide all three waste stream containers for customers (compost, recycling, garbage)
- Food Facilities within the City offering take-out shall provide options for customers to affirmatively request food ware accessories [e.g. condiment packets, utensils] separate from orders for food and beverages
- Plastic bags for takeout food are prohibited

## CITY OF SEBASTOPOL FACADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS



The City of Sebastopol offers a program aimed at encouraging local businesses and property owners to improve commercial and industrial buildings. Upgrades, maintenance, and aesthetic enhancements will benefit the entire community and enhance the local economy.

With these objectives in mind, subject to funding availability, the Sebastopol Façade Improvement Program will provide a rebate for expenses incurred on new exterior property improvements made to commercial or industrial buildings within the City of Sebastopol.

To apply for the program a building owner or tenant, with the owner's approval, should fill out the attached application and include bid estimates for the proposed improvement(s). The Planning Department then reviews the submitted application for completeness and batches them to be reviewed on a quarterly basis by the Design Review Board for approval. Deadlines for applications for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 are:

- August 15, 2022
- October 10, 2022
- January 9, 2023
- March 13, 2023




#### **KNOW YOUR ZONE**


