RECOGNIZING JUNE AS “LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, QUEER INTERSEX (PLUS) (LGBTQI+) PRIDE MONTH” IN THE CITY OF SEBASTOPOL

WHEREAS, throughout the United States during the month of June, celebrations, rallies, and parades will be held recognizing the diversity and strength that has developed in the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, Asexual, and Two-Spirit community; and

WHEREAS, since our founding, America has advanced on an unending path toward becoming a more perfect Union, including advancing the fair treatment of all people and defending and promoting human rights for all, as demonstrated on June 26, 2015, when the Supreme Court ruled in Obergefell v. Hodges that states must license and recognize same-sex marriages; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQI+ individuals in Sebastopol are productive, compassionate, and contributing members of the community; and

WHEREAS, at the City of Sebastopol, we call upon the community to celebrate the great diversity of the community, promote human rights, and create a community where all people, including those within the LGBTQI+ community, have the opportunity to feel proud and supported in their identity and sharing of their stories; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol will fly the pride colors throughout the month of June in support of Pride Month.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Mayor Neysa Hinton, and the City of Sebastopol City Council do hereby proclaim the month of June as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer Intersex (Plus) (LGBTQI+) Pride Month in the City of Sebastopol; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Sebastopol will proudly display the Pride Flag at City Hall throughout the Month of June.
