### TODAY

- Send a letter to the editor: use our easy <u>Letter-to-the-Editor Guide</u>.
- Sign the <u>coalition letter</u> and get your organization(s) to fill out this simple <u>sign-on form</u>.
- Share this list with your friends, email lists, networks, and social media.
- Email and call your <u>County Supervisor</u> (or all the Supervisors) to tell them you support doubling investment in transit ASAP.
- Sign up for June 13 & 14 actions (see below) JUNE 13
- Join the chalk art party on the evening of June 13 at the County Board of Supervisors offices (575 Administration Dr, Santa Rosa.) Chalk messages will greet the Supervisors when they arrive the next morning. << Sign up >>

#### **JUNE 14**

- Attend budget hearings in person with the visual impact team! We'll have signs to distribute, banners to be held and chalk for sidewalk art outside the building. We need more hands to make this happen! << Sign up >>
- Attend budget hearings to make public comment in person or by zoom (sign up to get notified once agenda/timing is released and text alerts when public comment time is coming) Sign up << Sign up >>
- We also need volunteers who can join Zoom to play a recorded comment from a transit rider who can't make it to the meeting.

### ONGOING

- Calling all storytellers, people who like to talk with others and document their stories! Help us record stories and public comments from bus riders. We need to uplift the stories of transit riders.

# WHY INVEST IN TRANSIT?

- We need to invest in safe, affordable, reliable, zero-carbon public transportation for all! It's about opportunity, mobility, freedom of movement, a liveable planet, and self determination!
- Transportation accounts for about 60% of our activity based carbon emissions.
- To reach zero carbon by 2030, we need to shift most of our trips from car to transit and active transportation (walking and biking.) Switching all drivers to electric vehicles is not feasible in this time frame, nor equitable because it does not help people who are not able to drive.
- We have an unequal system. People who don't drive have to waste hours of their week waiting for infrequent buses. Transit riders lose out on many educational, economic, and social opportunities. Investing in transit will help working class people, youth, elders, and people with disabilities who rely on the bus by reducing their daily expenses.
- We have a dangerous system. Those who can drive choose to opt out of public transportation, thereby contributing to a host of public health threats: greenhouse gas emissions, crowded roads, unhealthy air, and increased traffic casualties.
- Sonoma County is <u>far behind</u> on its equity commitments, <u>far behind</u> on addressing the climate emergency, and <u>far behind</u> on its Vision Zero traffic safety goals. And yet our leaders are still failing to properly invest in the one thing that would help us make rapid progress with all three of these important goals -- our Public Transportation System.
