

6. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

a. Tour of Libby Park and discussion

1. Highest Priority - Willard Libby Park POND FENCING

Fence Removal/replacement around Pond may need additional work & discussion agonized for a more formal review at a regular, recorded PC meeting.

- Repair fence
- Replace with the same materials
- Replace with alternate materials
- Replace with a low barrier to stop balls, trikes or small children
- Replace fencing in some areas, soften other areas with landscaping
- Remove all fencing and use landscaping to protect some areas, other areas open

Turtle Island needs landscaping

A sign is falling down on the island Can the water look less green?

Add more benches or low rock seating to south/west of Pond area Add trees near pond area

Reminder to community re the interface between Brook Haven School and park users Activate commemorative benches program for the parks

Park Rules Sign at Valentine Street entrance is sad (sign at south end is okay). Make bollard more visible with paint or reflective stripes.

New Patrick Amriott sculpture coming to Garzot Building Extend fencing to add a gate at entrance to Garzot Building

Power wash or clean power poles throughout park

Broken Asphalt Trails - remove some asphalt, but keep loops connected Bocci Ball Court is not level (Kiwanis) (west of pre-school building/north of pond)

Odd light pole(?) near Bocci Ball Court needs fixing or removal Commemorative rock area could be more interesting

Repair wood fence along south-east edge of park adjoining neighbors M

Survey community re how to use the mounded area

- stage and amphitheater
- Tom Sawyer's Island-like play area with rustic man-made rocks, caves Add shade trees along this asphalt trail so it is more like Valentine Ave.

Add shade trees, shrubs and taller grass clusters along fences at side and back and along pathways

GAZEBO maintenance items

Replace steps (or paint/stain repair dry rot) Repair loose handrail

Clear lichen from trellis

Add a volleyball court with sand?

Paint water valve near utilities (green at south entrance)

Questions about areas of the park:

Discussed how people could rent volleyball/nets and/or bocce and those types of sports equipment (difficult with no staffing/parks department, but potentially volunteer or machine?).

Parking lot behind Annex needs grading

Kiosk is in wrong place, trail head isn't clearly marked Garbage (on a Monday)

Trail guide numbers need QR codes/go online Amphitheater needs work. Maybe use all stone seating?

Drip line remnants need to be removed M

Playground Area

More large shade trees for structure and tables/benches Bridge Area

Vandalism on signs, both sides of bridge Consider removing fallen tree from waterway

2 New Americorp Trail improvements coming

South Kiosk Area Area needs a refresh

Remove fencing, landscape, add access trails from sidewalk and parking lot Replace wood sign poles with rusted steel posts throughout park

Peace Garden Area

Peace Garden looks mostly good. Seating in shady area is random Labyrinth memorial sign needs wood preserve and paint

Labyrinth needs structural work or re-design Needs a cluster of large stones for sitting

Tomodachi Park

Can't read sign at entrance

Slats missing and damaged in fence along west end (front of park) Garbage along ground near bridge abutment

Garbage along new trail to JR Trail. Does it connect? Graffiti on bridge abutment is a Cal Trans project
