### **INTRODUCTION/PURPOSE:**

This item is for the City Council to receive a report from the City of Sebastopol Housing Sub-Committee.

## **BACKGROUND:**

At its December 15, 2020 meeting, the City Council received a presentation from Sonoma County regarding the County's purchase and conversion of the Sebastopol Inn to house Covid-vulnerable individuals during the Covid emergency, and later as permanent supportive housing. At the meeting, the City Council tasked the Housing Sub-Committee to coordinate with the County as the project progresses.
