Whereas, She volunteered to teach English as a second language, served as a board member for the local library and shelved books there, organized and distributed food at a food bank, and prepared bag lunches for the unhoused; and

Whereas, She volunteered as a Board Member for LANTERN, who's mission is to build community support and funding for the development of a new library in Sebastopol, serving West County; and

Whereas, Ellen was a treasure and inspired others to build awareness of all that our library does for our community through her time with Friends of the Library as well as LANTERN, and

Whereas, Ellen dedicated her life to being a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother and friend; and:
