Dear Council Members,

My name is Vince Trotter, and I enjoy the good fortune of serving as President of the Board of Directors for Sonoma County Farm Trails. I am also a Sonoma County farmer, a member of the Sustainable Ag Advisory Committee at Santa Rosa Junior College and the Agricultural Ombuds for Marin County's University of California Cooperative Extension Office. Since I joined the Board of Farm Trails in 2014, I have also volunteered every year at the Gravenstein Apple Fair, helping to coordinate and direct ticket sales, cash-handling and parking as well as traffic into and through Ragle Park.

I write this letter to express my sincerest hope that you will grant our request for sponsorship of this year's Apple Fair. For years, we have valiantly worked with our dedicated volunteers to minimize back-ups along Ragle Ranch Road and ease congestion at the main entrance to the Fair. Last year, however, the City of Sebastopol generously provided us with the assistance of several members of the Sebastopol Police, and we witnessed firsthand the power of having experienced professionals manage such a critical intersection.
