SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING & TOWN HALL ON FIRE SERVICES DELIVERY - SEPTEMBER 26

The Sebastopol Fire Services Ad Hoc Committee has scheduled a Special City Council Meeting and Town Hall on September 26 at 6pm at the Youth Annex to discuss Fire Services in Sebastopol. The committee will present a report on its work and provide

an opportunity for the City Council to ask questions. They will also conduct a Town Hall for members of the public in an effort to achieve a comprehensive long-range vision for the future of Fire Services in Sebastopol. The meeting agenda will be available on the city website by September 21. COMMUNITY GARDEN WORK DAY OCTOBER 8



The Sebastopol Climate Action Committee (CAC) is working on a project to revitalize the Sebastopol Community Garden. They are planning a work party on Oct 8 from 10am to 1pm to continue the revitalization begun last spring.

Volunteer groups and individuals are invited to help with weeding, pruning, and spreading compost from the Compost Give Away around the fruit trees. The group also hopes to bring a sander and paint to restore the picnic table under the roof. Volunteers may bring gloves and any tools they may have such as shovels (flat and pointed), loppers, pruners, etc.

The Sebastopol Community Garden is located in the Laguna Skategarden Park at 343 Flynn St. (at Laguna Park Way).

CALL FOR SCULPTURE GARDEN SUBMISSIONS

The Sebastopol City Council and its Public Arts Committee (PAC) invite Sonoma County-based sculptors to submit proposals for the design, fabrication, and installation of durable and lowmaintenance original public art suitable for placement upon one of 5 available sculpture pads of the Sebastopol Community Sculpture Garden to be on display for two years. Proposals will be accepted through November 6, 2023.

The Sebastopol Sculpture Garden (CSG) is located in Ives Park, along the pedestrian walk between Ives Park Creek and the Sebastopol Center for the Arts. There are currently 7



sculptures by local artists on display and 5 concrete platforms are available for new sculptures to be selected by the Sebastopol Public Arts Committee and approved by the City Council.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE TO IMPROVE WALKING & BIKING IN OUR COUNTY



SONOMA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

The Sonoma County Transportation Authority (SCTA) is currently recruiting for its Countywide Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee (CBPAC). The City of Sebastopol invites interested citizens to volunteer and apply for one (1) opening on The

Countywide Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee as a citizen representative. The open position is to fill a vacancy for a resident living within City Limits. The representative will hold the position and have an indefinite term until they retire or resign.

The CBPAC advises the SCTA on programming decisions for bicycle and pedestrian facilities, and aids in project coordination and planning. It is composed of representatives from each bicycle advisory committee in the cities and County. Applications will be accepted starting September 18th to Monday, October 30th, 2023 by 4:00 PM. <u>Application and more information</u>.

CITY PROJECTS THAT MAY IMPACT TRAFFIC

Bodega Avenue Bike Lanes and Pavement Rehabilitation Phase 1. Construction of concrete pedestrian ramps continued during the month and, but for 2 remaining ramps locations, all others have been completed and are in use by the public. Pavement overlay on Bodega Ave from High St to Nelson Way is scheduled tentatively for mid-October. This will be a 2-day operation and traffic control will be in effect however. delavs expected are to occur. Currently the project is on track for completion within the 90-working days contract



end date of 11/21/23. This work is partially funded with local sales tax Measure M Transportation funds.

SR 116 Curb Ramps and Crossing Enhancements at Bodega/Florence and Bodega/Robinson. All but 1 of the concrete pedestrian ramps have been completed and in public use. The remaining ramp location at Wallace St and N Main St is on hold until PG&E relocates an existing electrical facility in conflict with the new sidewalk grade. This work is partially funded with local sales tax Measure M Transportation funds.

Ives Park Pathway Replacement Segment 1. Construction has been on hold from its previous planned August start up due to the final special events scheduled at the park. The work is planned to begin Monday, September 18 after special events for the summer have concluded. Duration of work is estimated to be 30 days from start, pending unforeseen conditions or inclement weather. As a reminder the extent of work is to replace existing asphalt path with new ADA-compliant path from the picnic table area to the public restrooms near the central play area.

Parquet Street Water/Sewer/Slurry Seal Improvements. Utility construction is ongoing with the new waterline installed and pressure testing and disinfection to follow starting the first week of September. Installation of new water service and fire hydrant connections are continuing during the same week as well. Other work planned to start later in the new month include new sewer main and manhole construction and installation of the new sewer laterals.


Education and awareness for protecting our creeks and watershed is not just something that happens annually.
