CITY COUNCIL PROCLAIMS OCTOBER 2023 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH



At its October 3rd meeting, the Sebastopol City Council issued a <u>Proclamation Declaring October 2023 as Domestic Violence Awareness</u> <u>Month</u> in the city of Sebastopol.

SONOMA COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY WAITLIST LOTTERY OPEN 10/1-10/31

The Sonoma County Housing Authority is happy to announce that its Housing Choice Voucher waitlist lottery is open through October 31. The Housing Choice Voucher program – formerly known as the Section 8 program – provides financial assistance to very low-income individuals and families to enable them to afford housing in the private rental housing market.



After the close of the application period, 750 applicants will

be randomly selected for placement on the waitlist. All those who are placed on the waitlist can expect to have an opportunity for service within two years. For those who are not placed on the waitlist, application periods for project based voucher waitlists will be opening in the near future.

COMMUNITY GARDEN WORK PARTY - OCTOBER 8TH





The group also hopes to bring a sander and paint to restore the picnic table under the roof. Volunteers may bring gloves and any tools they may have such as shovels (flat and pointed), loppers, pruners, etc.

DON'T LET YOUR GUARD DOWN!

A message from Interim Fire Chief Jack Piccinini: It's been a quiet fire season up and down the state and we have had a mild summer including some moisture in the past week, but don't let your guard down-we are still in fire season. The Oakland Hills fire was the week of October 19th, the Tubbs fire was the week of October 8th, and the Camp Fire was in November. All of these fires



occurred on the heels of a mild fire season that was shattered by a fall wind event. Now is the time to clear fall leaves and pine needles from your roof tops and cleaning out gutters is critical to prevent embers from landing on those fuels. Clean up hazardous fuels around the yard and maintain a defensible space.
