Subject: Sebastopol Solid Waste Collection Services Rate Adjustment ("Refuse Rate Index" – RRI)

Effective July 1, 2024

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**RECOMMENDATION**: This item is to request the Council authorize the Sebastopol Solid Waste Collection Services Annual Rate Adjustment "Refuse Rate Index" (RRI) by the City's solid waste contractor, Recology Sonoma Marin ("Recology"). Annual rate adjustments are permitted upon City review and approval as per Section 7.3 of the provisions of the Agreement between the City and Recology.

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#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

On December 16, 2008, Council adopted Resolution 5723 and entered an agreement (Agreement) with a local solid waste collection and hauling firm, Redwood Empire Disposal, Inc., also known as "The Ratto Group". The Agreement covered solid waste, recyclable materials, and compostable materials collection, as well as street sweeping services. Subsequently, on September 19, 2017, the Council approved the assignment of the Agreement from Redwood Empire Disposal to Recology. The original Agreement was effective January 1, 2009 and initially had a fifteen (15) year term. This was later extended by one year and was set to expire on December 31, 2024, and has since been extended through June 30, 2025.

The City received a letter from Recology dated April 24, 2024 (Attachment 2) requesting an annual rate adjustment effective July 1, 2024. The Annual Rate Adjustments are similar to a CPI adjustment and tied to inflation. Rate increase is an obligation of our contract and standard practice. Our rates would remain comparable to other jurisdictions.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Agreement Section 7.3 is titled "Adjustments to Maximum Collection Service Rates" which describes the fee elements and rate adjustment methodologies.

7.3.1 ADJUSTMENTS TO DISPOSAL COMPONENT. Using the Refuse Rate Index (RRI). Beginning on July 1, 2009, and annually thereafter, CONTRACTOR shall, . subject to compliance with all provisions of this Article, receive an annual adjustment in the Collection Components of the following maximum service rates as set forth in Exhibit H to this Agreement.

7.3.2 RRI ADJUSTMENT. Beginning on July 1, 2009, and annually thereafter during the term of this Agreement, the Collection Component of the maximum service rates set forth in Article 7.3 .1 above shall be adjusted by the RRI adjustment set forth below. In any year that the calculation of the RRI results in a negative number, there shall be no adjustment of the Collection Component. Instead the RRI number shall be the result of the cumulative change in the RRI for the two year period prior and shall be the RRI adjustment for that subsequent year.

In simple form, a "Refuse Rate Index", or RRI, is calculated and applied to several service components, such as Single-Family Dwelling, Multi Family Dwelling, or Commercial Collection service rates (typically per bin or level of service per month) based on several factors affecting costs such as fuel rates or landfill tip fees, for example and more accurately reflecting the costs experienced by waste haulers than a simple CPI adjustment. The RRI calculation in the proposed letter from Recology has been reviewed for accuracy by the City's consulting firm, R3 Consulting Group Inc.

Recology is required to apply to the City for potential rate adjustments based on complex formulas described in the Agreement, which must be timed to allow changes to be effective July 1 of a given year. Recology submitted their new proposed rate sheets and supporting calculations on their letter dated April 24, 2024 (proposed annual rate adjustments included in letter, attached).

#### ANALYSIS:

Single family rate change for single cans weekly pick-up would range between 3.4-3.6% per month, with the actual monthly rate changes effectively in the range of \$0.61 cents per month to \$3.10 per month; the most commonly used 32 gallon size would rise \$1.05 cents per month. Commercial single can and bin weekly pick-up rates are requested to rise in the range of 3.3-4.3% per month. The actual monetary amount of the commercial single can and single bin increases between \$11.50 per month and \$34.69 per month; while the often used 4 cubic yard bin weekly pick-up would be increased by \$25.37 per month.

A summary listing of the proposed rates as compared with current rates is shown in the table below.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEBASTOPOL AUTHORIZING ADJUSTMENTS TO SOLID WASTE RATES CHARGES BY RECOLOGY SONOMA MARIN EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2008, City Council adopted Resolution 5723 and entered into a Franchise Agreement (Agreement), effective January 1, 2009, with a local solid waste collection and hauling firm, Redwood Empire Disposal, also known as "The Ratto Group; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement covered solid waste, recyclable and compostable materials collection and street sweeping services; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, on September 19, 2017, City Council approved the assignment of the Agreement from Redwood Empire Disposal to Recology Sonoma Marin (RSM); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was set to end by December 31, 2023 and has since been extended through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Section 7.3 of the Agreement provides for annual adjustments to solid waste rates via Refuse Rate Index (RRI); and

WHEREAS, the City received a letter from RSM dated April 24, 2024 (copy attached to this Resolution) requesting an RRI adjustment to solid waste rates effective July 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City engaged R3 Consulting Group, Inc. (R3) to review RSM's RRI adjustment request for accuracy and adherence to the terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, upon review, R3 found the requested adjustment to solid waste rates to be calculated accurately and per the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing for said RRI adjustment was conducted on June 4, 2024 to receive public comments.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Sebastopol, as follows:

1. Solid Waste Rates charged by Recology Sonoma Marin as listed in the April 24, 2024 letter from Recology Sonoma Marin, are hereby authorized and effective July 1, 2024.

The above and foregoing Resolution was duly passed, approved, and adopted at a meeting by the City Council on the 4th day of June 2024.

Dear Don,

Per Section 7.3 of the franchise agreement, please find the proposed adjustments to Recology Sonoma Marin (RSM) service rates using the refuse rate index (RRI) for the rates effective July 1, 2024 though June 30, 2025, including any supporting documentation.

The RRI indicates an average increase of 3.48% for July 1, 2024. The 32G Residential cart rate in Sebastopol will increase by 3.57% or \$1.05, and the 4 Yard Commercial bin will increase by 3.86% or \$25.37. The rate changes are defined by changes in rate components as follows:

- 1. Disposal Component increases by 6.08% based on the increase in the MSW tip fee.
- 2. Organics Processing Component increases by 8.65% based in the change in organics processing fee.
- 3. RRI/Collection Component increases by 1.87% based on the weighted average change in publicly available Bureau of Labor Statistics indices for Labor, Fuel, Vehicle Replacement, Vehicle Maintenance and Consumer Price Index.

Following this letter is the rate application documentation including component increase calculations, a complete rate table, and a chart comparing the new Sebastopol rates with surrounding areas. Attached in a separate document are the Recology Sebastopol Audited Financial Statements for FY2023 and an excel version of the rate application to assist with review.
