City Councilmembers, Staff, and Community Members,

I support the approval of Agenda Item Number 8, which will appoint a City Council Liaison and direct the Police Chief to explore a West County Homeless and Mental Health Support Team. This program is essential to addressing critical community needs with a more compassionate, effective, and fiscally responsible approach. Key reasons for support include:

- **Reduced Burden on Law Enforcement**: Civilian responders will address non-violent mental health and homelessness crises, allowing police officers to focus on crime prevention and traditional law enforcement activities.
- **More Effective Crisis Response**: Trained professionals will handle mental health, addiction, and homelessness issues, ensuring individuals receive the right care and reducing unnecessary criminalization.
