## NEW FACES AND NEWS ROLES FOR SEBASTOPOL TEAM

The new year brings a changing of the guard among our city's leadership. In December, the City Council selected Diana Rich as mayor and Stephen Zollman as vice mayor. Both are serving in their roles for the first time. Don

## SEBASTOPOL CITY COUNCIL ELECTS NEW MAYOR AND VICE MAYOR

At its December 5 meeting, the Sebastopol City Council elected Vice Mayor Diana Gardner Rich as mayor and Councilmember Stephen Zollman as vice mayor for the next year. Outgoing Mayor Neysa Hinton will now serve as a regular city councilmember.

Mayor Rich has been active in local community service for over twenty years including seven years as the executive director of the Sebastopol Community Cultural Center. She was elected to the City Council in 2020 and served as vice mayor in 2023. This is her first term as mayor.



Vice Mayor Zollman is a social justice attorney, former San Francisco Public Defender, and American Bar Association Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Commissioner. He was elected to the City Council in 2022. This is his first term as vice mayor.

## DON SCHWARTZ IS SEBASTOPOL'S NEW CITY MANAGER



The City of Sebastopol welcomes Don Schwartz as its new city manager. Mr. Schwartz previously served as the assistant city manager of Rohnert Park since April of 2014, where he provided leadership to successfully attract new businesses to the city, contributed to balanced budgets each year, helped to establish a positive working environment, and increased community engagement.

Mr. Schwartz has almost thirty years' experience working in government, community service and nonprofit leadership, including nine years with the County Administrator's Office for the County of Sonoma. Additionally, his background

includes twenty years managing complex budgets emphasizing fiscal responsibility, balanced budgets, healthy reserves, leveraging resources, and long-term financial planning, all of which are valued assets as Sebastopol navigates challenging financial times. Mr. Schwartz holds a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from the University of California, Berkeley and a Master of Public

Policy from Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government.

### PROTECT BACKYARD FLOCKS FROM AVIAN FLU

The Sonoma County Board of Supervisors has declared an emergency following detection of avian influenza at two local poultry farms.

Poultry producers and backyard flock and pet bird owners are urged to increase their biosecurity practices, including wearing clean or dedicated shoes and clothing, washing hands and preventing



or limiting visitors to poultry and bird areas in order to reduce the risk of accidental exposure to the virus.


