Water

1. Coordinate with residents to complete lead and copper sampling requirements for the state.
2. Identified and replaced a failing water service line as well as restored the asphalt driveway.
3. Continuation of meter box inspections for lead service inventory required for State Water Board.

Storm Water

1. Addressed the concerns about a storm drain on Ragle Rd.

Sewer

1. Restored asphalt surface over previously completed sewer repairs on Murphy Ave.
2. Identified and replaced two sections of sewer laterals that were reaching the end of their useful life.
3. Restored asphalt roadway and concrete sidewalk after completion of sewer repairs.
4. Completed the quarterly maintenance of main line that runs along Zimpher creek.

Streets

1. Removed and restored a failing section of pavement in front of the Fire Department driveway on Jewell Ave.
2. Continued painting crosswalks and curbs around school zones for pedestrian safety.
3. Installed safety warning signs along school pedestrian routes 2 weeks prior to the start of the school year.
4. Continuation of pruning downtown street trees to improve pedestrian safety.
5. Addressed pothole concerns along Bodega Ave.
6. Coordinated with PG&E to get power restored to streetlights along Fore Way.

Parks

1. Installed asphalt overlay on one section of pathway to improve pedestrian safety.
2. Removed a large broken tree limb from the community garden that was hindering garden access.

Government Buildings

1. Completed construction management of ADA improvements project at the Youth Annex.
2. Performed annual check of the solar panels along with collecting production information for the year.
3. Started annual cleaning of the solar panels to increase their efficiency.

Parking Lots

1. Trimmed vegetation to improve visibility for vehicle and pedestrian safety.

Park Village

1. Replaced one streetlight that was starting to fail to improve vehicle and pedestrian safety.

Ives Pool

1. Coordinated with Sonoma County to complete annual facility inspection.
