Measure U tax increase campaign funders, vague goals and concerns

I think citizens should be fully aware of who is funding the very vague and expansive claims to justify the proposed city of Sebastopol half cent sales tax increase, which might generate a few hundred thousand more dollars per annum. This amount is a drop in the ocean compared to what is needed but is being backed by the conservative with a small 'c' local old guard to justify a modest top up of what is left in their punch bowl.

If money was being very **specifically raised to fund public safety or our water system** (the most urgent needs based on the city citizen survey) that would be unusually focused behavior, but the old guard are claiming a very wide array of possible benefits if this measure passes, which is disingenuous to put it mildly.

If money was being raised with the specific intent of hiring talent to develop local business sales tax generation via rejuvenation, business development and attracting new businesses to our empty store fronts that would be a viable budget ask, but sadly we have the usual suspects shaking the tin donation cup so we can carry on with the Sebastopol Tomorrow' (or Sebastopol Bankrupt Tomorrow' as they should be renamed) goal of no change or modernization except 'sustainability' (sic).

The comfortably off shadowy individuals who fought tooth and nail to prevent the CVS store from being built and who spend endless hours protesting any sort of city development are now proposing the county's highest sales taxes but the worst road surfaces (something many of them like as it makes tourist visits less likely). The 'Sebastopol Tomorrow' website is years out of date with ancient historical goals still listed. This is a backwards looking organization more focused on utopian elimination of cars, gas supply and tourism.

The audacity of past councillors who created the current fiscal fiasco proudly endorsing yet more tax increases is astounding, and they will no doubt shortly be joined by current mayor Rich next year to continue to operate the city unencumbered by the Brown act via their proxies.

Current mayor Rich even has the chutzpah to suggest you don't love Sebastopol unless you support paying more taxes.



Predictably the money funding the doorstep flyers and marketing collateral is from the SEU who understandably want their members to be paid, and the local backroom bourgeoise chipping in funds to keep their agendas alive and the city struggling.

There is no question our new city manager and hard working staff desperately need additional revenue streams to continue to operate the city, but ask yourself how much of an impediment the specific people asking you to pay more taxes are to the future survival of the city.

What's left of local business are now struggling with much higher water rates, inflation, the seasonal lull in tourist trade...and now the highest taxes in the county. If you are going to vote yes I suggest you attempt to make council accountable so the extra sales tax generated doesn't disappear into the general fund to be used on councillor's future pet projects.
