## Noteworthy Information

- 1. Responded to four (4) fires and one (1) cardiac arrest:
  - a. Structure fire and vegetation fire on Ferguson Road
  - b. Vegetation fire on Bloomfield Road
  - c. 8361 (Type-3 engine) responded to the Line Fire in Southern California for two weeks
  - d. Shopping cart fire at O'Reilly Media
  - e. Cardiac arrest with CPR
- 2. Seven (7) occurrences of simultaneous calls this month where the initial apparatus was committed on a call requiring another FD unit or mutual aid. Additionally, there were several instances where the response involved only one firefighter.
- 3. Fire prevention conducted <u>21</u> inspections in the City (including initial and follow-up)
- Public education event at Fircrest Mobile Home Park. Firefighters taught hands-only Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), Automated External Defibrillator (AED), and Narcan delivery.
- 5. The Sebastopol fire station now has an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) mounted on the exterior for public use during a cardiac arrest. The AED and wall cabinet were provided by the Gold Ridge Fire Protection District.
- 6. 8350 (Ladder Truck) has returned and is in service.
