## Dear City Staff and Council,

I am writing to add my voice to the urgent requests for a permanent Ceasefire Resolution in Gaza. I consider myself a member of Sebastopol's community, despite being just outside city limits. My son goes to school in Sebastopol and it is important to me that he be raised in a community that stands up for human rights when and where those rights are being violated. Sebastopol has done so before and is known as Peace Town. The suffering of the Palestinian people has been live-streamed 24/7, for 137 days. As of today, the number of fatalities in Gaza exceeds 29,000, with so many more buried under rubble or otherwise unaccounted for. 65% of the civilians killed in Gaza are women and children, and thousands more permanently disabled and suffering from starvation. UNICEF estimates that at least 17,000 children in Gaza are orphaned or separated from parents. All of the 2.4 million residents in Gaza are facing not only a constant threat of death or injury, but also an ever increasing threat of starvation and sickness. You are in a position to lead in this regard, and I know that if you approach this from a position of peace and love for humanity, for animals, and for land, you will bring back and adopt a Cease

Fire Resolution as soon as you can.
