Addendum No. 3

This addendum shall be incorporated into and considered part of the specifications for the aforementioned RFP as if it had been issued simultaneously. This addendum includes updated responses to proposer questions #15, #16, and #39 (see below). These represent all additional questions that could be answered.

Question #15

Q: Please provide bulky item tonnage data.

A: See the table below:

Note that currently bulky items are paid for by Sebastopol customers, so there are probably fewer than if the program was free. Tonnage information is not available.

Question #16

Q: Please provide a definition for "Industrial Service Recipient."

A: "Industrial Service Recipient" means a customer subscribed to Debris Box or Roll-off collection service. Formal definition will be added to the Agreement during contract negotiations.

Question #39

- Q: Section 15.01. Recovered Organic Waste Procurement. Is the contractor required to assist the City in fulfilling 100% of their SB 1383 annual procurement target, or rather only required to provide up to the '50 cubic yards' as noted in the same section of the draft agreement? If contractor is required to assist the City in fulfilling 100% of their annual procurement target, will the City please note what their annual target is relative to tons of compost?
- A: Contractor shall provide 50% of the City's full SB1383 Annual Procurement Target, which amounts to 178 tons or 445 cubic yards annually.
