Annual User Fee Update to Maximize Cost Recovery - The city annually reviews and adjusts the fees it charges for various services to ensure that the fees cover the actual costs of providing those services.

- User Fees:
 - Planning Fees, such as entitlement review and review for compliance with the zoning code
 - Building Fees, such as permitting of new construction or modifications to existing structures
 - Engineering Fees, such as map review, encroachment permitting, and public improvement review
 - Fire Prevention Fees, such as fire sprinkler, fire alarm, and other permit review
 - Police Fees, such as vehicle impound and false alarm response
 - Reserved Park Area, Facility Use Fees, and Special Event Fees

EMS – Emergency Medical Services. This term covers services provided by paramedic, ambulance, and medical providers such as clinics and hospitals as part of the EMS system.
