It will highlight some unusual or unknown neighborhood features as well as a delightful rest stop at Andy's with coffee, energy snacks, outdoor seating, and restrooms. The mileage is estimated at 4.6 to 5 miles and it will likely take the full 3 hours. No dogs, please.
